To ensure that the Town of Vernon's Public Warning Siren System functions properly when needed, the Office of Emergency Management will be conducting monthly siren tests. Utilizing new digitally secure radio technology, Vernon's Public Warning Siren System will be activated at 12:00 noon on the first Saturday of each month beginning in April, 2007. Each test will last for approximately 3 minutes.
